Hickory Hills resident, Christopher Knights addressed the Board regarding a donation to the Justice Park District, of an amount "not to exceed \$1,000," which was approved by the Roberts Park FPD at the January 10, 2023 meeting.

Mr. Knights expressed concerns of the Fire District donating tax-payer funds to support a neighboring tax district's programs, when the Fire District funds should be used to support its own programs, i.e. public education, and purchasing necessary equipment needed for daily operations of firefighting and rescue.
